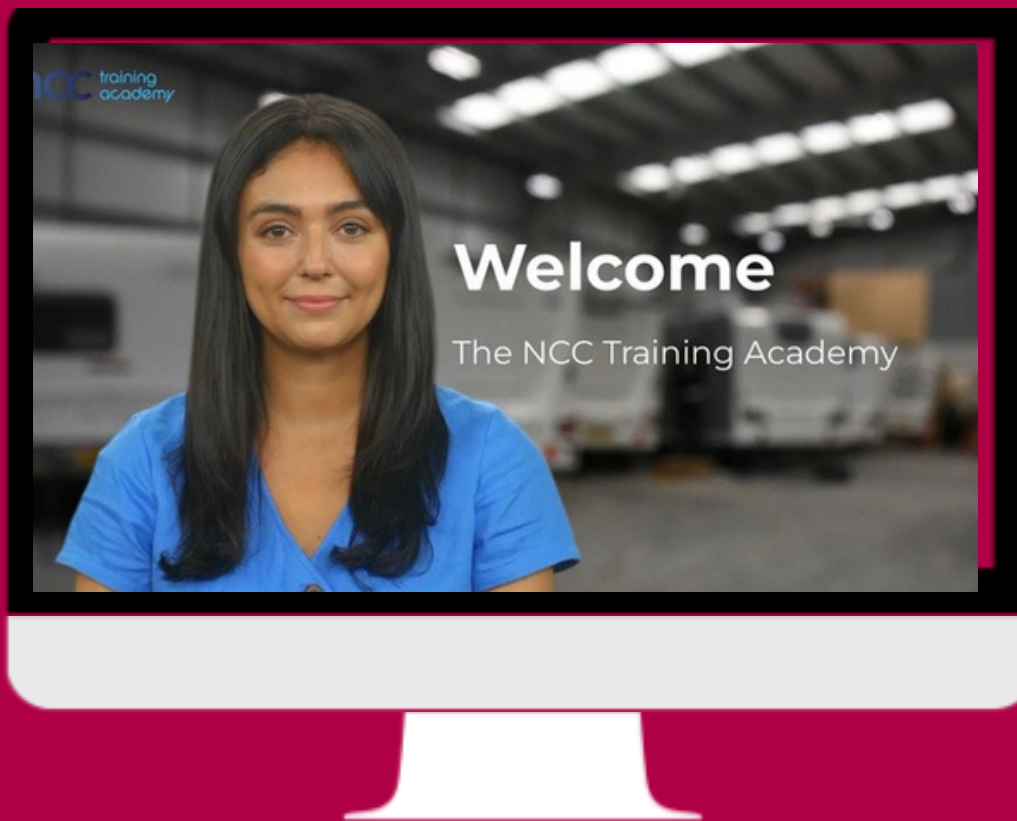

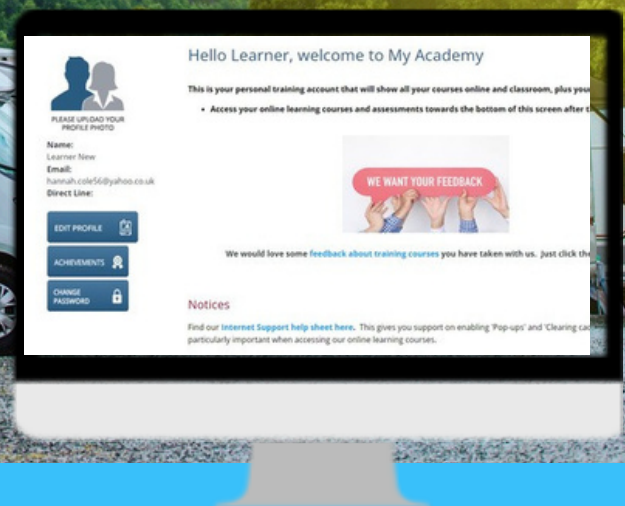

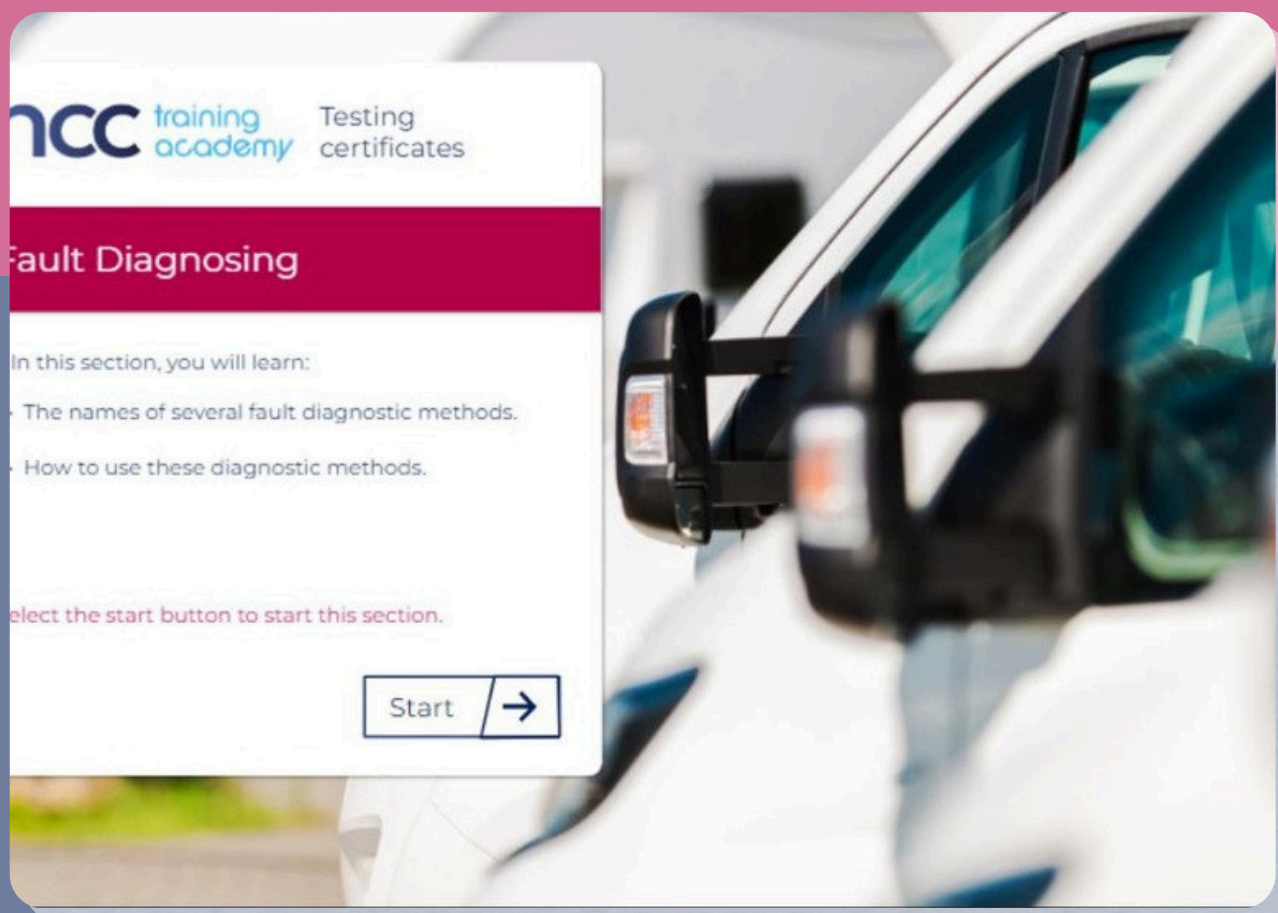


These courses are an alternative route of learning to our traditional classroom-based courses known as:

We are making our online learning as accessible as possible, so everyone can achieve the level required to be a service operative or technician.

What do these courses cover?

These courses consist of three levels, so you can train to the level suitable to your role.

Level 1: Leisure Vehicle Service Electrical Operative

Prerequisite: None

Assessment: Multiple Choice online exam

Validity: 5 years Renewal: online refresher

Level 2: Leisure Vehicle Service Electrical Technician

Prerequisite: Level 1 or Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award

Assessment: Multiple Choice online exam

Validity: 5 years Renewal: online refresher

British Standards

Protective devices

Wire Circuit types

Solar Panels

Relays

Insulation

Ohms law

Note: Completion of Level 1 & 2 is the equivalent of completing Electrical Test & Inspection and Electrical Systems & Circuits or Classroom Level 1 & 2. To cover electrical compliance for your AWS application, you must complete Level 1 & 2.

What do these courses cover?

Level 3: Leisure Vehicle Periodic Inspection Report

Prerequisite: Level 1 & 2 completed or classroom T&I and ELV

Assessment: Multiple choice online exam

Validity: 5 years

Renewal: completion again

This level covers the procedure and requirements for the periodic inspection report.

ASSESSMENTS

We will assess your learning through the **Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award** & virtual assessment tools.

Level 1: Once you have completed the online learning, you will complete an online multiple choice exam. Then, you can move onto Level 2.

Level 2: You will be assessed at the end of each module via multiple choice questions. If you do not pass a module, you cannot move on until you successfully complete it.

Practical Assessment: To fully achieve Level 1 & Level 2, you will demonstrate your practical skills through the Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award. This is a four hour practical assessment, performing a full service. Think of the Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award as the final award, bringing all your skills together. You should complete your electrical and gas training before you complete your Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award.

Level 3: You will be assessed at the end of each module via multiple choice questions. If you do not pass a module, you cannot move on until you successfully complete it. There is no practical assessment for this level.

CERTIFICATION

You will receive a certificate for each level you successfully complete once you have completed all elements of training.

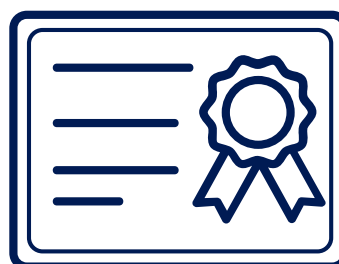

FAQs

How do I book?

Individuals – you will be able to book your training online on our website: www.nccacademy.org.uk

Each level is bookable separately, you can book one at a time or multiple levels, but you will only receive access to the next level once you have completed the previous level and passed any written & practical assessments.

Once you have booked online, we will check your eligibility and then confirm your booking via email. An invoice will follow which must be paid in full before you are allowed access to your online learning. Once access is enabled, you will have access for 6 months.

If you do not complete your learning within the allotted time frame, your access will be revoked and you would need to book again.

Workshops – you will be able to book your training online for your technicians online on our website: www.nccacademy.org.uk

Each level is bookable separately, you can book one at a time or multiple levels, but your learners will only receive access to the next level once they have completed the previous level and passed any written & practical assessments.

Once you have booked online, we will check eligibility and then confirm the booking via email. An invoice will follow which must be paid in full before your learners can access the online learning. Once access is enabled, you will have access for 6 months. If your learners do not complete the learning within the allotted time frame, access will be revoked, and you would need to book again..

FAQs

What if I don't pass?

We require you to show understanding of all elements of the training.

Therefore, if you do not pass the online portion, you must retake it before you are able to complete your Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award.

FAQs

How long after completing level 1 can I move onto level 2?

Your level 1 certificate is valid for five years, so you can move onto level 2 at anytime during that period. However, you should aim to move straight onto level 2, so your expiry dates are similar.

Please note if there is an extended time period between completing level 1 & 2, you may need to complete separate refreshers upon expiry.

What if I have already passed the Caravan Service Award?

If you have already passed the Caravan Service Award, you would not need to complete it again. If you have completed it within the last 5 years, you can go straight to level 2. If you completed it over five years ago you would need to complete level 1 & 2.

What Level do I have to train to, to be eligible for the Approved Workshop Scheme?

To be eligible for the Approved Workshop Scheme, you must complete Level 1 & 2. please contact the Approved Workshop Scheme for further clarification on their application requirements.





FAQs

How do I progress through the online course?

Level 1: You will complete the learning modules, and then be assessed at the end via multiple choice questions. You can revisit any learning module as many times as you need too.

Level 2: In level 2, you are assessed as you go through the course, so you don't have to take a lengthy exam at the end. Once you complete a section of learning, you will be assessed on that section via multiple choice questions. You must pass the previous section before you can move onto the next one. You can revisit any section as many times as you like.

Once you have completed & pass both of these (and your STGW training) you are able to take your Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award.

What if I fail my Caravan Service Award?

You would need to retake your Caravan/Motorcaravan Service Award to achieve your electrical certificates.

FAQs

What devices can I use to complete my learning?

Our online learning is compatible with the following devices: Desktop - Laptop - iPad - Android tablet. We do not recommend using phones due to their limited text and image sizes

How can I ensure best performance?

We recommend you use a desktop or laptop with google chrome if you can. Clearing your cache & cookies before starting will also help with best performance.

- A good stable Wifi
- Don't have a lot of other tabs open
- Ensure 'pop ups' are allowed

What happens when my certificates expire in five years?

You will be required to complete an online refresher. This will be a mixture of revision, with any important updates you should be aware of, and multiple- choice assessment questions.

Do I have to do my learning at certain times?

No! Our online learning is accessible 24/7 anywhere with WiFi. You can dip in and out as you please, the courses will save your progress. Take it at your own pace, in the workplace or at home. Please check our opening hours if you require technical support.
